






Approved Zoning

- Retains existing zoning districts where development has occurred
- Delineates one <u>consolidated Open Space district</u> on the perimeter of the base
- Creates one new <u>Mixed Use Development District</u> (MUDD) over all undeveloped areas
- Includes <u>Technical Studies</u> (Water, Sewer, <u>Transportation</u>, Stormwater) that support the new zoning



Coordinate with the Town of Weymouth and SRA to provide water to the base, including filing a **JOINT PETITION** to join the MWRA.


Aquaria

INFRASTRUCTURE: Sewer

Weymouth

- Estimated total sewer from Base: 1.2 MGD
- Weymouth sewer system improvements:
 - EPG study November 2022
 - Capacity upgrades to address future town growth and future Base flows

Rockland

- Estimated sewer from Base : 0.4 MGD
- Significant I/I issues identified through various studies
- Collaborate with the Town to identify capacity improvements for future Base flows

Abington


- Estimated sewer from Base: 0.3 MGD
- Continue to flow to Brockton WWTP
- Improvements to Abington System in collaboration with the Town

INFRASTRUCTURE: Transportation



TRAFFIC STUDY INCLUDES 73 INTERSECTIONS:

- Updated Study of 73 intersections assessed in prior filings
- Review of current status of roadway and intersection improvements
- Engagement with MassDOT and local communities is on-going

- Mitigation approach to reflect physical improvements, trip reduction (TDM) strategies and Complete Streets design principles
- Coordination of recommended improvements with current and planned improvements by others, including the adjacent communities
- Establishment of a Union Point Transportation Management Association to serve the redevelopment
